

ASSOCIATE IN ARTS (AA)

- Satisfy all Admissions requirements.
- Earn a minimum of 60 semester hours of credit to include the following General Education requirements:
 - Communications** - 9 credit hours
 - Arts & Humanities** - 9 credit hours
 - Social Behavioral Sciences** - 9 credit hours
 - Math/Science/Technology** - 9 credit hours
(If Math 102 - Intermediate Algebra is taken, then 3 more credit hours must be taken in this area to give a total of at least 12 hours instead of 9 hours.)
- Fulfill enrichment requirements of 2 semester hours.
- Academic Skills Courses (ASC) will not fulfill general education requirements and cannot be included in the semester hours required for an Associate in Arts degree.
- Earn at least 15 semester hours of institutional credit from BSC.
- Achieve a minimum 2.00 grade point average in at least 60 semester hours, including a 2.00 grade point average in all credits from BSC.
- Clear all college obligations.
- File an "Application for Graduation" in the Dean of Student Service's office at the beginning of the semester/term in which student expects to complete requirements for graduation.
